

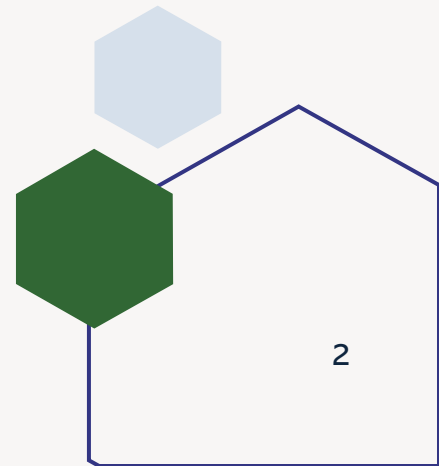

Reports Required to be Submitted by Stationary Sources

Emissions Reports

All permitted sources, except for GSPs, submit an annual emissions report (may include VOC or NOx annual report)

~ 280 reports per year

Annual/Semi-Annual Reports

58 sources that are subject to Title V, NESHAP, or NSPS submit most of their compliance reports annually or semi-annually.

~ 210 reports per year

CEMS Reports

12 Title V sources, which submit quarterly emission and audit reports

~140 reports per year

Stack Test Reports

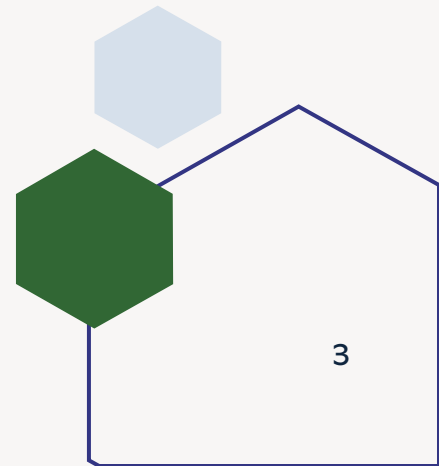
Permitted sources conduct stack tests and RATAs each year requiring pre-test protocols, final reports, report revisions and other correspondence.

~ 60 tests conducted per year with over 120 reports per year

Permit Deviation Reports

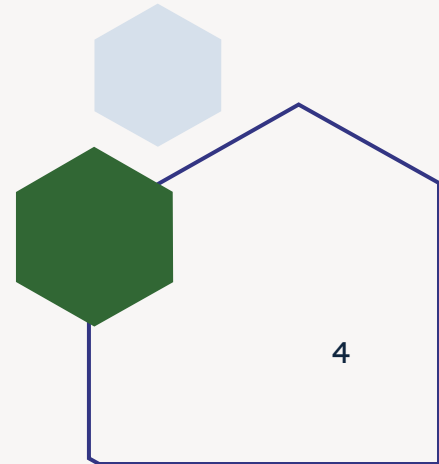
Permitted sources may need to submit reports of deviations from permit requirements.

~ 50-75 reports per year



Why Online Reporting?

- Eliminate hardcopy and email report submittals.
 - Online forms have the same data fields and require the same information as paper forms.
 - No mailing costs for sources.
- Reduce reporting errors with the use of drop-down picklists and data field formatting.
- Streamline multiple report submittal by requiring a separate online submittal for each report.
- Reduced data entry for sources.
- Use previous submittals as a template for starting new reports.
- Accept attachments for supporting information to electronic submittals.
- For TV sources, online submittal replaces separate submittal for original signature.



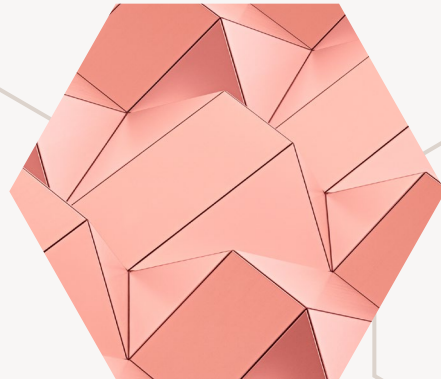

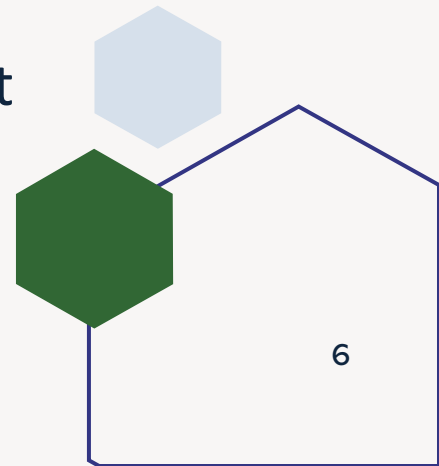
1. General reporting

- All reports/notifications required by a permit (e.g. NSPS/MACT reports, CEMS audits and reports)

2. Stack test report submittal

- Pre-test protocols
- Final test reports and revisions

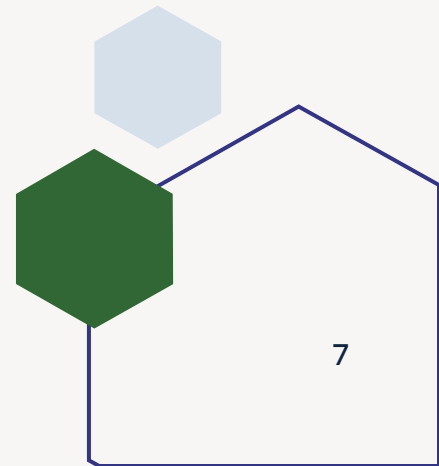
Note: Reports req'd to be submitted via CEDRI will still need to use that method for reporting to EPA.



Register for NH Forms Online Reporting

To use NH Forms to submit reports:

1. Go to <https://onlineforms.nh.gov/nform/> and select “Create Account”.
2. Enter your name, email address, phone number, and password, then submit.
3. NH Online Forms (BusinessOneStop@nh.gov) will email you a confirmation code.
4. Enter the confirmation code, then sign in with your username and password.
5. Use “Form Search” to find the appropriate form or use one of the links shown on the next slide.
