

## **NH Air Pollution Regulation Changes**

What?: NH Code of Administrative Rules Subtitle 'Env-A'

Roadmap for NH regulation of air pollution

**Underlying Requirements** 

State statutes

Federal regulations

Direct: Requirements for stationary sources

Indirect: NH plan to satisfy federal requirements

#### Why?: Constant Change


Address changes in underlying requirements

Rule complete May 2022


Delegation request pending

#### Adoption of Updated Federal NAAQS (complete May 2022)

PM<sub>2.5</sub> annual 15.0 to 12.0 ug/m<sup>3</sup>

Ozone 8-hr 0.075 to 0.070 ppm

## **Upcoming Changes**

#### **Affirmative Defense**

Current USEPA guidance = no 'affirmative defense' Multiple rules:

Env-A 1900 Incinerators

Env-A 2100 Particulate Matter & Visible Emissions Standards

Env-A 2400, Ferrous and Non-Ferrous Foundries, Smelters, and

Investment Casting Operations (in progress)

#### Startup/Shutdown/Malfunction Exemptions

Current USEPA guidance = no blanket exemptions

Establish SU/SD requirements

Env-A 2000 Fuel Burning Devices
