

FRIENDS OF AINE CENTER FOR GRIEVING CHILDREN & FAMILIES

Christine Phillips and David Phillips founded Friends of Aine in 2013. The nonprofit agency provides bereavement support services and resources to children and families who have suffered the death of a loved one. The couple was compelled to act following the sudden and unexpected death of their daughter Aine (pronounced Ahn-ya) at age 8 in 2010. Aine's younger sister, Bella, who was 6 at the time, inspired a journey that has helped hundreds of children in New Hampshire. David and Christine found a small and limited 8-week program with Home Health & Hospice Care in Merrimack. When finished, Bella told her parents she wanted to do more, which led to creating Friends of Aine as a fundraising organization to support the Merrimack program. The Manchester-based Friends of Aine has since grown to provide support services through three 8-week sessions, using a peer-to-peer model and small groups for children and adults.

DEAN CHRISTON

Dean Christon served as executive director and CEO of New Hampshire Housing from 2007 through 2021 and previously was assistant executive director, deputy director of administration and chief operating officer. His tenure at New Hampshire Housing covered 34 of the self-supporting public corporation's first 40 years. New Hampshire Housing's mission is to promote, finance and support housing solutions for the people of New Hampshire. Since it was founded in 1981, New Hampshire Housing has helped more than 55,000 families purchase their own homes and has been instrumental in financing the creation of more than 16,000 multifamily housing units. Christon continues his advocacy and community support through his service as chair of the Advisory Board of the Saint Anselm College Center for Ethics in Society, and as a trustee for both NeighborWorks Southern New Hampshire and Catholic Charities New Hampshire.

SENATOR LOU D'ALLESANDRO

Sen. Lou D'Allesandro of Manchester has served in elected office in New Hampshire for over 45 years including his current run of 13 consecutive terms in the state Senate. The "Dean of the Senate" is known for his passion for education and helping others. Sen. D'Allesandro's political resume includes serving in the House from 1973-1974 and 1997-1999, the Executive Council from 1974-1980 and ten years on his local school board. He also twice ran for governor. Sen. D'Allesandro began his professional career as a high school civics teacher in New Hampshire and went on to serve as president of Daniel Webster College and Nasson College, and vice president of Franklin Pierce University. He is an alumnus of the University of New Hampshire, earning a bachelor's degree in history in 1961 and later a master's degree from Rivier University in 1971. The senator serves on the Board of Directors of Southern New Hampshire Services, a community action program.

SHERILYN "SHERRY" BURNETT YOUNG

Sherry Young, founder, shareholder and past president of Rath, Young and Pignatelli, has stood out for decades as one of New Hampshire's best lawyers. Focusing on environmental law and litigation, she is annually featured among "The Best Lawyers in America" and Thomson Reuters' *Super Lawyers*. She received *NH Business Review*'s "Outstanding Women in Business Award" in 2019 and was named one of the Granite State's 200 Most Influential Leaders by *NHBR* in 2020. In 2000, she was the first woman elected to chair the State Capital Group, an international association of independent law firms, and received the 2007 Marilla M. Ricker Achievement Award for women lawyers who achieved professional excellence or paved the way for other women lawyers. Young serves on the board of directors of Walden Mutual Bank and the University of New Hampshire Foundation, the Dean's Advisory Board of the UNH Franklin Pierce School of Law, and as chair of New Hampshire Public Radio's Board of Trustees.
