

What is the AFFF Take Back Program?


- -A state funded program to remove PFAS containing AFFF foams.
- NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF Environmental Services

- -AFFF= aqueous film forming foam
- -Municipal fire departments
- -Airports

Why?

-To avoid future ground water and soil contamination sites














NHDES awarded the contract to Revive Technologies
