What is the AFFF Take Back Program?

-A state funded program to remove PFAS containing AFFF foams.

-AFFF= aqueous film forming foam

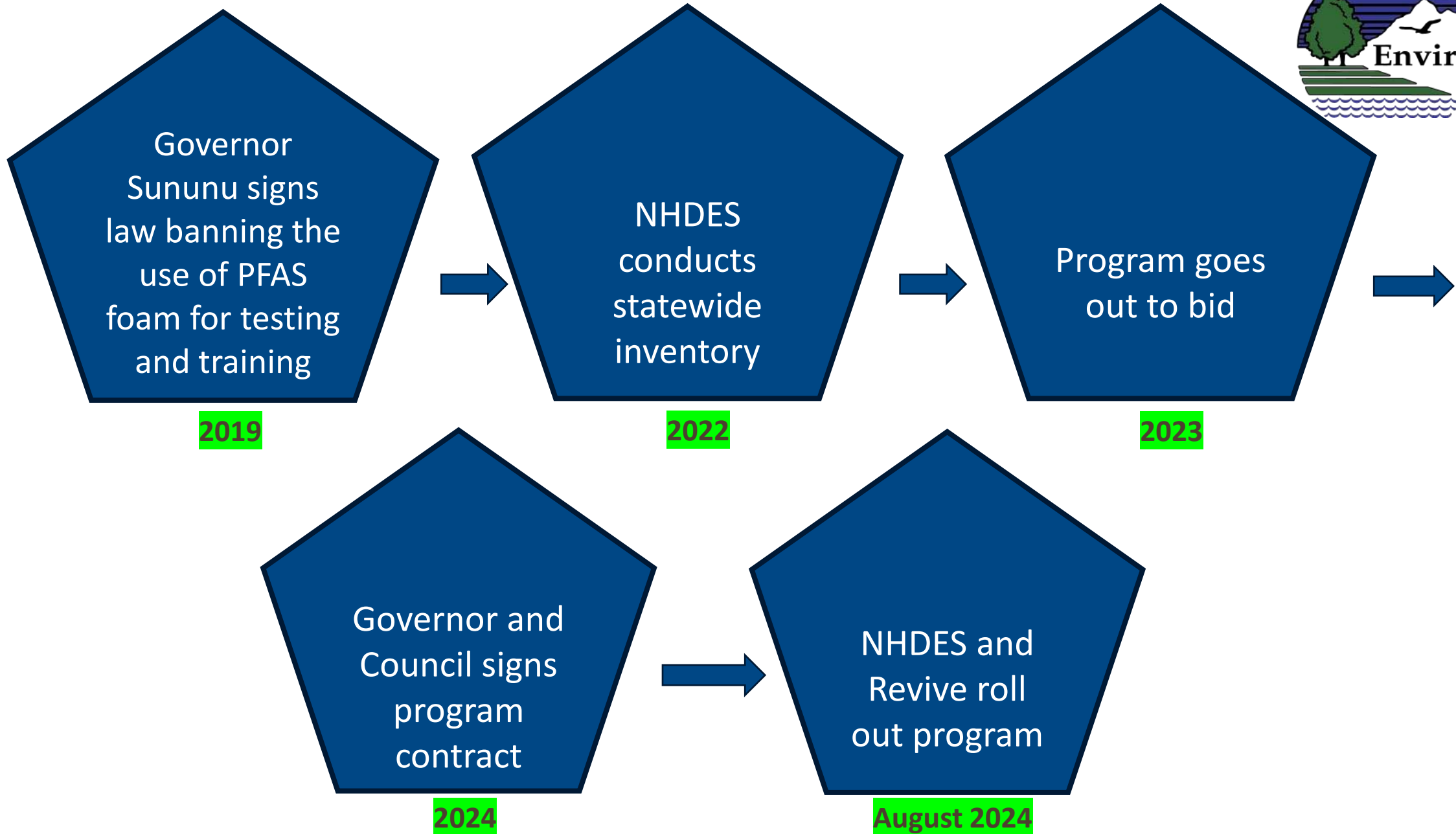
-Municipal fire departments

-Airports

Why?

-To avoid future ground water and soil contamination sites







NHDES awarded the contract to Revive Technologies

-Transportation and logistics through Republic Services

-Personnel for ten pick up locations

-Online container registration system

-Permitted SCWO treatment facility in Columbus, OH for complete PFAS destruction.
