Program Initiative – Early 2022



- > 9,000 private wells sampled
 - 3,500+ PFAS AGQS exceedances
 - > 2,000 with no third party assistance

\$5M approved

• ~ 900 households




Money Trickles Out


- August 2022

- Approx. 1,100 rebates
- \$4.5M disbursed
- Average rebate \$3,800

- September 9 new application form available






- Owners of residential properties
